## ACCOUNTANT'S COMPILATION REPORI

To the Beard of Trustees

Rapid City, South Dakota
We have compiled the accompanying statement of financial position of FIRST CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH as of December 31, 2012, and the accompanying supplementary schedules of treasurers' reports (selected budget to actual information) for the month of Deecmber and the year-to-date January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012, and the year-to-date for the prior year, which is presented only for supplementary analysis purposes. We have not audited or reviewed the accompanying financial statement and supplementary sehedules and, accordingly, do not express an opinion or provide any assurance about whether the financial statement and supplementary schedules are in accordance with accounting principles generally aceepted in the United States of America.

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statement and supplementary schedules in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America and for designing, implementing, and maintaining internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statement and supplementary schedules.

Our responsibility is to conduct the compilation in accordance with Statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The objective of a compilation is to assist management in presenting the financial information in the form of financial statements and supplementary schedules without undertaking to obtain or provide any assurance that there are no material modifications that should be made to the financial statements and supplementary schedules. During our compilation, wo did become aware of departures from accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America that are described in the following paragraphs.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require that fixed assets be depreciated over their estimated useful lives. Management has informed us that the Organization has not computed depreciation on fixed assets. The effects of this departure from accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America on financial position. results of operations, and cash llows have not been determined.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require the Organization to report information regarding its financial position according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets. The Organization has not reported its financial position according to the three classes of net assets. The effects of this departure from accounting prineiples generally accepted in the United States of America on financiai position, results of operations, and eash flows have not been determined

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require that unconditional promises to give be recorded in the period pledged. The Organization records pledge revenue when cash is received rather than when earned or promised, unless the pledge is received in advarice of the period of intended use. In such cases, the pledge revenue is shown as prepaid pledges, rather than revenue. The effects of this departure from accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America on financial position, results of operations, and cash flows have not been determined.

Management has elected to omut substantially all of the disclosures required by accounting pronerples generaliy accepted in the United States of America. If the omitted disclosures and the statements of changes in net assets and cash flows were included in the financial statements, they might influence the user's conelusions about the Organization's financial position, results of operations, and cash flows. Accordingly, the financial statements are not designed for those who are not informed about such matters.

## 1st Congregational Trust

The First Congregational Charitable Trust, Inc. is an independent corporation dedicated to the management of invested funds on behalf of the congregation. Its mission is to solicit and manage financial gifts provided for use in charitable and educational projects beyond the regular operating budget of the church.

The fixed income funds of the trust are invested with the United Church of Christ's Cornerstone Foundation. Equity funds are invested with the United Church Foundation and with Edward Jones.

Recently the Trust reeived two major gifts: \$5,000 from the Lois Vaughn Estate and an anonymous donation of $\$ 40,000$.

The assets of the Trust as of December 31, 2012 are \$429.035.37.
In 2012, the Trust awarded two Power of One scholarships: Trent Eddy and Siri Palm each received $\$ 750$. The trust has now awarded $\$ 5,750$ since this scholarship program began four years ago.

Further, over the past years, the Trust has provided 109 Change of Career grants for a total of $\$ 65,420$.

From the beginning, the Trust has also helped fund other projects that support the mission of the church but are outside the regular budget.

The trust also manages three designated scholarship funds: The Zona White Fund; The Inabelle Willard Fund; and the Humke Fund. This year, the Zona White account awarded $\$ 1,500$ to Trent Eddy and $\$ 1,000$ to Jessica Dunaway. The fund received a $\$ 150$ donation from Jane Becker.

An ongoing project of the Trust is the Power of One Campaign that invites members of the congregation to include in their estate planning a gift of $1 \%$ to the Trust to sustain and continue the work of the First Congregational Charitable Trust. Several members have responded to this appeal.

Current members of the Trust Board are: Jack Bossen, Arnett Dennis, Verna Ehresmann, Lia Green, Pat Lebrun, EdMcLaughlin (chair) and Shirley Sackman. Rev. Ted Huffman is an ex-officio member.
